Minutes for February 18, 2005

The meeting of the Community and Junior College Band Director's Association was called to order on February 18, 2005, at 3:07 p.m. by President Shaw Furlow. The reading of the minutes of the December meeting was dispensed because of the posting of the minutes on the web page.

John Ungurait then brought up that Northeast Community College was in violation of the Association bylaws, and article IX of the State Board of Community and Junior Colleges bylaws for recruiting violations. Northeast director of bands Ricky Bishop sent e-mails to 10 out of district schools and letters to at least 10 others, asking for senior list along with posters advertising Northeast scholarship auditions. The Association unanimously condemned this violation leaving action to be taken by the Northwest, Holmes, and Itawamba presidents.

The meeting was closed at 3:55 p.m. by president Furlow.
